The Forest Operator – Faller Training program is tuition-free and designed to provide eligible participants with hands-on experience and vocational training in the forest industry. The program will include employability and occupational skills training including forest sector training, professional development, initial 30-day New Faller Training and on the job work experience.

To apply for this tuition-free program, applicants must:

- Meet the definition of an EI client
- Be eligible for WorkBC Case Management and be referred by a WorkBC Case Manager
- Have a valid driver's licence

This full-time 21-week program runs at Okanagan College in Penticton.
